Benefits of Proposals

The key benefits of the Greenway Park scheme include:



Retaining visitors in the South Downs National Park with associated increased visitor spending in the local area.



Maximising use of existing public rights of way including existing links between Petersfield, Queen Elizabeth Country Park, Shipwrights Way and the nearby South Downs Way.



Reducing vehicle movements in this part of the South Downs National Park, through the promotion of cycling and walking.



Biodiversity improvements and habitat recreation, including:

- Native and wildflower planting
- Retention of existing boundary trees and vegetation together with supplementary planting around boundaries and across the site
- Protection and enhancement of existing habitats including boundary buffers for dormice and dark corridors for bat foraging
- Surface water management / SUDS in the eastern part of the site linking to the existing watercourse along the south-east boundary to create wetland habitat.
